
MIND SWEEPER COVER HISTORY

The following were the first two "working" covers of the book.






(Above): First and second book covers for "Mind Sweeper."


It was a bit difficult to decide on a cover concept for *Mind Sweeper*. The story is somewhat unique, not really typical of any fictional genre.

This cover almost made the final cut:




(Above): Alternate book cover for "Mind Sweeper."
